The "Yi Coffee" opposite the Site of the First National Congress of the Communist Party of China offers customers a unique experience by combining a revolutionary history with daily life.

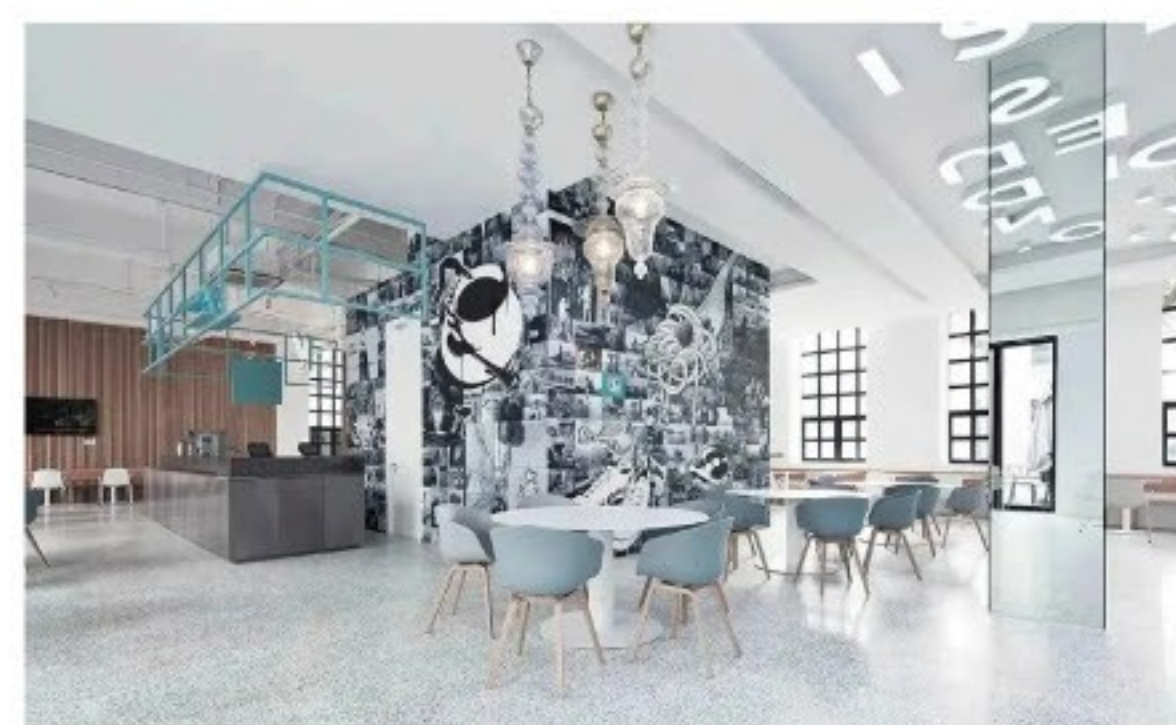

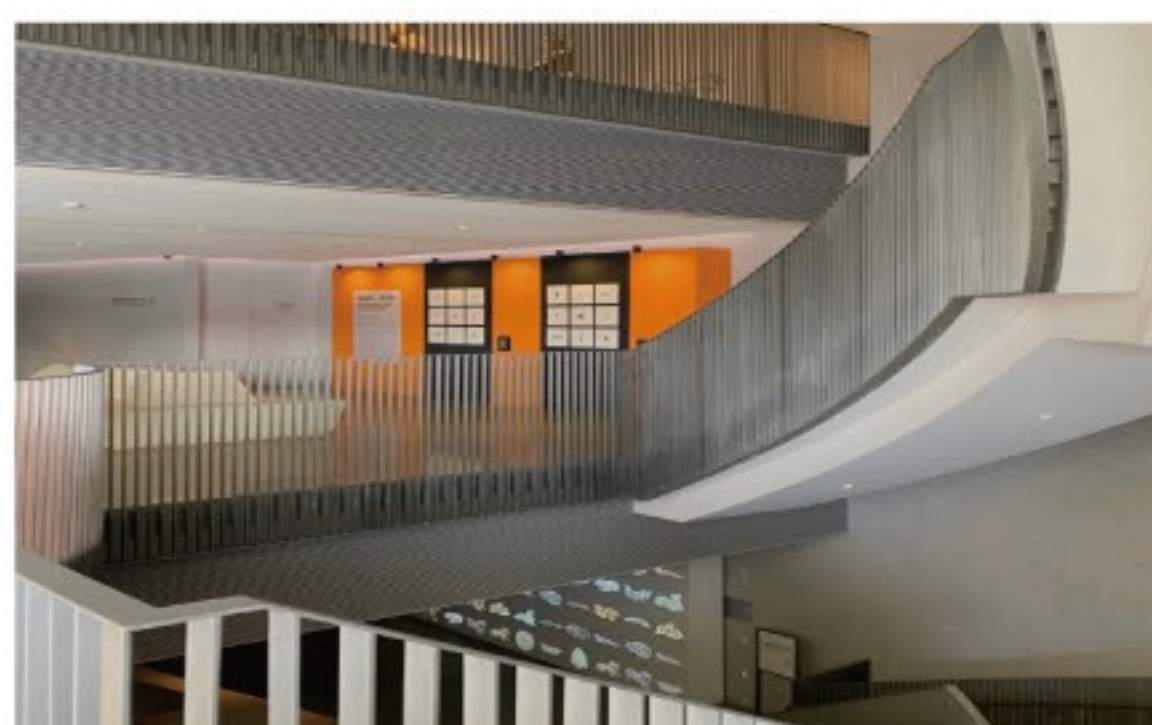
