Era - Intersection of Time at Shanghai Circus World

Shanghai Era Entertainment Ltd. launched the *Era - Intersection of Time* show in 2005. The show had been performed every day until 2020, winning multiple awards, such as the Project of China National Classic Stage Arts. The *Era2 - Spirit of Shanghai* show has retained the positioning of the Era brand: "Chinese elements, Chinese-foreign cooperation, Chinese stories, international expression". Combining modern technology and Chinese acrobatic art seamlessly, the *Era2*, as a resident show at Shanghai Circus World, presents a perfect audio-visual experience for Chinese and foreign audiences.

Shanghai Romance Park

Located at the Expo site beside the Huangpu River, it is a brand new performing park that goes beyond imagination. There are more than ten theatres and performance venues in it, such as the Romance Theatre, the Performing Arts Theatre and the Music Square. A grand song and dance *The Romantic Show of Shanghai*, a kids show *WA! Dinosaurs* and a 5D live show *The Earthquake* take turns to be staged. These innovative, interactive and immersive multi-media experiences offer visitors an art feast of Shanghai.

Dream Cruise

The immersive drama *Dream Cruise* is performed on the Huangpu River in Shanghai. It is the first immersive mobile theatre on water in the city. With a suspenseful theme and science fiction elements, the play tells the story of a handed-down "luminous pearl" on a cruise ship on the Huangpu River in the 1930s. The play mainly targets young audiences and combines the performance with river views. While watching the show and appreciating the scenery, audiences can take part in interesting evidence-collecting plot interactions and experience a fantastic journey through time and space.

Secret Love in Peach Blossom Land

The play is one of the most celebrated works of Chinese-language theatre artist Stan Lai. It tells a story about two third-rate theatre troupes, *Secret Love* and *Peach Blossom Land* who compete for a rehearsal stage. In 2017, an exclusive version of the play was born on the stage of Theatre Above, performed by a strong cast of the Performance Workshop trained by Stan Lai himself. In 2023, the exclusive version started resident performances at Theatre Above, allowing more people to find an "ideal theatrical retreat" in the bustling city center anytime.

The Solitary Gourmet

The theatre is adapted from *The Solitary Gourmet*, a highly acclaimed IP work. For the first time, the concept of "dining in earnest" combined with the love as in *We Made a Beautiful Bouquet* is integrated into a theatric performance. During the play, the audience in each zone enjoys a different immersive dining experience in a Chinese restaurant built after the real scenes in Chinatown. Such a "small environmental theatre" is different from the traditional proscenium stage, and the space can be freely adjusted according to the content of the play. The combination of "performance + experience" allows both to be upgraded and updated continuously.

Sleep No More

The immersive classic *Sleep No More, Shanghai* has remained popular since its premiere in Shanghai in 2016. Breaking the "fourth wall" stage boundary of traditional drama and taking aesthetic inspiration from the film noir movies, the play presents the adaptations of multiple classic literary works, films and TV series, including Shakespeare's classic tragedy *Macbeth*. With its unique theatrical experience and international-level artistic quality, it brings audiences into an immersive theatrical fantasy world.

Classic Performing Spaces



Mercedes-Benz Arena
No. 1200, Shibo Avenue, Pudong New Area
China Art Museum
Mercedes-Benz Arena is both an international live entertainment venue and a mixed-use entertainment complex, with a Main Stage, a small Live House and a Retail District.



Shanghai International Dance Center
No. 1650, Hongqiao Road, Changning District
Shuicheng Road
It is currently the only cultural venue dedicated to dance in Shanghai, the first professional dance center in China and even in the whole Asia, and a world-class dancing art base ranking among the best in China. It will be a new cultural landmark of Shanghai.



Shanghai Dramatic Arts Centre

Changshu Road
As the only national-level professional drama group in Shanghai, it draws artists from all over the world with its openness and inclusiveness, and attracts audiences with rich diversified stage works. It is a modern world-class theatre with international prestige, equal to the status of the city.



Shanghai Oriental Art Center
No. 425, Dingxiang Road, Pudong New Area
Shanghai Science and Technology Museum
Located in the Lujiazui Financial City of Pudong New Area, the Shanghai Oriental Art Center is one of Shanghai's iconic cultural facilities. Viewed from a height, the Art Center looks like a beautiful phalaenopsis orchid with its five "petals" hosting respectively the lobby, the recital hall, the concert hall, the exhibition hall and the opera hall.



Shanghai Poly Grand Theatre
No. 159, Baiyin Road, Jiading District
Baiyin Road
It is the first theatre in China to have a water-scape auditorium. With beautiful surroundings, complete facilities and convenient transportation, it provides art fans with world-class artistic enjoyment. Put into operation in 2014, the theatre is the first top-notch artistic venue in western Shanghai.



Bank of Communications New Bund 31 Performing Arts Center

Oriental Sports Center
The new performing arts center opened at the end of 2023 has hosted various important performances. Foresighted and creative, it incorporates performance appreciation, artistic immersion, cultural transmission and social space, bringing visitors a cultural lifestyle that nourishes creativity with art.

Theatres in Huangpu District



Shanghai Grand Theatre
No. 300, Renmin Avenue, Huangpu District
People's Square
It is the first modern theatre in China built as per the standards of international first-class theatres. The shape of "crystal palace" implies an ancient Chinese belief that "sky is round and earth is square". It has become a display platform for world-class artworks, a communication platform for international art activities and a promotion platform for public art education.



Cadillac - Shanghai Concert Hall
No. 523, East Yan'an Road, Huangpu District
People's Square Dashijie
As China's first professional music performance venue, the concert hall was designed by Fan Wenzhao and Zhao Shen, two of the first group of Chinese architects who had studied abroad. It was completed in 1930 and renamed Shanghai Concert Hall in 1959. The concert hall is the center of Shanghai's music activities and a cultural landmark of the city.



Shanghai Xin Guang Theatre
No. 586, Ningbo Road, Huangpu District
People's Square East Nanjing Road
Its predecessor is the Strand Theatre built in 1930. China's first sound film *The Singing Peony* starring Hu Die was released here. After Shanghai was liberated, the theatre had been dedicated to Shanghai Opera for a long time. It had been renamed several times and also served as a cinema. Its reconstruction was completed in 1994, turning it to the present Xin Guang Theatre.



Shanghai Tianchan Yifu Theatre
No. 701, Fuzhou Road, Huangpu District
People's Square
Founded in 1925 and formerly known as Tianchan Stage, it is the only theatre in Shanghai that stages Peking Opera mostly and is the oldest existing theatre in the city offering performances of traditional Chinese operas. It was once acclaimed as "the largest theatre in the Far East". People used to say, "A Peking Opera actor has to perform at Tianchan to become famous." In 2021, it returned with a new look.



Chang Jiang Theatre
4F, No. 35, Huanghe Road, Huangpu District
People's Square
Formerly known as Carlton Theatre, founded in 1923 and designed by Laszlo Hudec, designer of Park Hotel, the theatre is an important drama performance venue in Shanghai. In 2018, it was rebuilt. Now it incorporates multiple functions, including carrying forward experience, educational promotion and cultural exchange.



HuangPu Theatre
No. 780, East Beijing Road, Huangpu District
People's Square
Its predecessor is the Lyric Theatre known as "a palace of Chinese films". It was in this old cinema that the film *Children of Troubled Times* (1935) was premiered and the Chinese anthem *March of the Volunteers* was first sounded as the theme song of the film.



SAIC - Shanghai Culture Square
No. 597, Middle Fuxing Road, Huangpu District
South Shaanxi Road
The site of the square was originally the French-built "Canidrome", which was later rebuilt into the city's cultural square. It is a palace of art in the greenery and the world's largest underground theatre, equipped with high-tech, changeable and multi-functional stages, firstly in the country integrating the fountain and ice-making installations and high-tech means into the creation of musicals.



Shanghai Dashijie
No. 1, South Xizang Road, Huangpu District
Dashijie
Dashijie (Great World) built in 1917 used to be the largest amusement venue in the Far East. The renovated Dashijie offers visiting citizens and tourists richer cultural experiences. In the daytime, there are nostalgic traditional farce shows and shadow plays; in the evening, visitors can enjoy dramas, musicals and immersive game plays presented by Mahua Fun Age and other troupes.



Shanghai Gong Stage
No. 433, East Yan'an Road, Huangpu District
Dashijie
As one of the four major Peking opera stages in Shanghai in the past, it was famous for presenting Shanghai-style Peking opera that features trick settings and long serial plays. Later, Gong Stage was renovated and reopened in 2010 as a permanent venue for the stage show *Era - Intersection of Time*.

Performing Spaces in Shopping Malls

There are over 100 theatres in Shanghai, and every one of them attracts fans of shows. Some of them are "hidden" in crowded shopping malls.

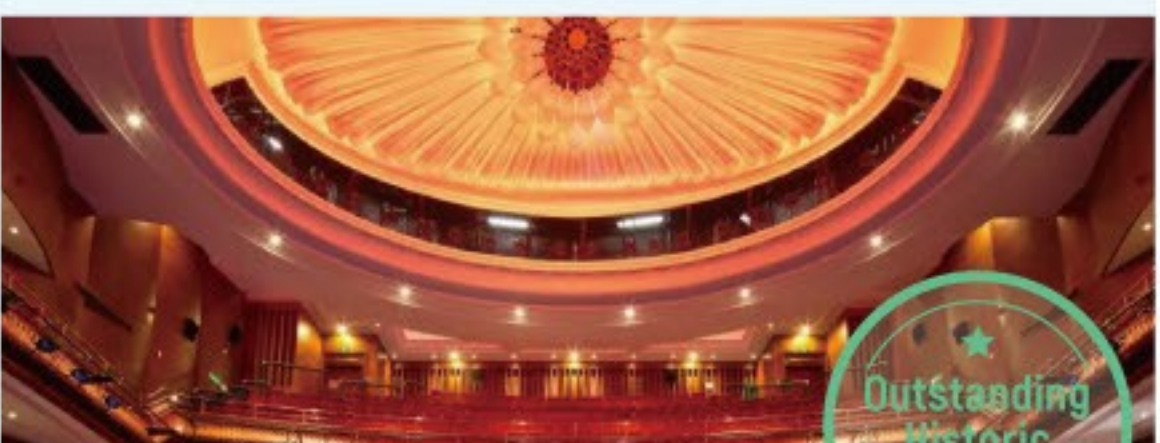

Shanghai Lyceum Theatre
No. 57, South Maoming Road, Huangpu District
South Shaanxi Road Middle Huaihai Road
It is the first Western-style theatre built after Shanghai opened its port to foreign trade, originally owned by the Lyceum Theatre Custody Committee of a British amateur drama club in Shanghai. Since its removal to the current building in 1931, it has remained in use.



The Great Theatre of China
No. 704, Niuzhuang Road, Huangpu District
People's Square
It was one of the four major Peking Opera stages in Shanghai. In the 1940s, many Peking Opera masters including Mei Lanfang had graced the stage. In 1944, it was named The Great Theatre of China. In 2018, the theatre's renovation project was completed successfully.
