

Introducing Henan

Nestled in central China along the middle and lower reaches of the Yellow River, Henan, abbreviated as “Yu”, is a province rich in history and culture, home to over 100 million people. Here, you can marvel at UNESCO World Heritage Sites like the Longmen Grottoes, Yin Ruins, and the Historic Monuments of “The Center of Heaven and Earth,” as well as a journey along the roots of the Silk Road and the Grand Canal. This is where China’s “Four Great Inventions” — the compass, gunpowder, movable-type printing, and papermaking — took root. An impressive 73 of the 100 most common Chinese surnames originated here, and Henan boasts the richest collection of ancient relics and cultural artifacts in China. Visiting Henan is like walking through a vast historical and cultural gallery, where the depth and magnificence of Chinese history come to life.



The people of Henan, known for their wisdom and resilience, have contributed profoundly to Chinese culture. Shaolin Kung Fu, a symbol of strength and skill, and the graceful balance of Tai Chi have captivated global audiences. 



Documents:

Don't forget to bring your passport, as it will be required for flights, trains, and purchasing tickets for scenic spots.



Payment:

In star-rated hotels and key scenic spots, foreign card POS machines and foreign exchange points are installed, rendering payment highly convenient.

Many booking and ride-hailing apps require a local SIM card. Visitors are encouraged to purchase a Chinese SIM card at the airport or a local service provider's office. This will make it easier to book taxis, tickets, and even order food while traveling. Commonly used takeout ordering apps comprise Meituan, Ele.me, Dianping, and so on.



Mobile Connectivity:

Henan has extensive mobile coverage. For extended stays, you may want to buy a local SIM card or contact a telecom provider

([China Mobile 10086](#), [China Telecom 10000](#), [China Unicom 10010](#)) for international calling plans.

Transportation



Public Transport:

Henan offers convenient options for travel by air, train, and long-distance buses.

The Zhengzhou Xinzheng International Airport ([Kundenservice Flughafen Xinzheng 0371-96666](tel:0371-96666)), China's train booking portal (<https://www.12306.cn/index/>), and Henan's long-distance bus ticketing network ([Verkaufsplattform für Busfahrkarten in Henan www.hn96520.com](https://www.hn96520.com)) make navigating the province easy. For attractions located further from urban centers, travelers may need to use the metro, city buses, or taxis. For extended stays, visitors can purchase local metro or bus cards using their passport for easier access to public transportation.



Ride-Hailing Services:

Popular ride-hailing apps like Gaode Maps and Didi make booking a taxi effortless, while self-driving enthusiasts can use rental apps such as Shenzhou Zuche and eHi Car Rental. After downloading and completing registration, you can easily book a ride or car rental online.



Accommodation:

Guests can check into hotels directly with their passports or make advance reservations via booking platforms such as (<https://www.ctrip.com/>), Airbnb oder TripAdvisor Hotels, Options include hotels, boutique inns, and youth hostels.
